The NHI card serves as a reference for national health insurance. For card replacement, NHIA offers convenient access to services via mobile phone, internet and counter service.



Ways of collecting the NHI card:
collection via registered mail or on-site collection by
appointment (within 2-7 working days)

Counter service for on-site collection



 For those who have applied for a card replacement but not received yet, they can have NHI medical services with the receipt for application and their ID and filling out the NHI exceptional access to medical care form at the contracted healthcare provider.

2. Newborns may access NHI medical services with one of the parents' NHI cards up to 60 days after birth.
